What is my annual commitment?

All St. Elizabeth School families are required to spend \$3,000/year (June 1, 2017 through May 31, 2018) on the Dollar\$ 4 Dollar\$ program.

What is the \$4\$ envelope for?

For your convenience, each family has been provided with a Dollar\$ 4 Dollar\$ envelope. You will use this envelope to send in your orders, and it will be returned to you with your cards enclosed. IF you are not placing an order on a particular week, keep your envelope and use it when placing your next order.

How can I order stocked gift cards?

To order stocked cards, complete an order form, attach your check made out to “St. Elizabeth School Scrip”, and place it in your Dollar\$ 4 Dollar\$ envelope. Return your envelope to the school by Friday and your cards will be delivered the following Thursday via the weekly “Brown Envelope”.

For immediate delivery, you may go to the office during the hours of 7:30AM – 9:30AM or 1:30PM -2:30PM to purchase cards from Carol Palmieri.

How can I order a non-stocked gift card?

Go to the school web site. Under the Resources Menu, click on Dollar\$ 4 Dollar\$. Once you have clicked on the link, you will see both the regular order form and “Monthly Order Form Dollar\$ 4 Dollar\$”. Fill out the Monthly Order form and return it to the school office. Retail scrip orders will be placed once a month. **All orders that are placed by the 1st Friday of the month, will be delivered the following Thursday in your “Brown Envelope” with the youngest child.**

Also, you may go to www.shopwithscrip.com to place an order for non-stocked gift cards. First, you have to register with our school's enrollment code. View the Scrip On-Line document for step-by-step instructions. Once you have been verified you can place your order online. You can pay for this order via Presto Pay on the website or send in a check made out to "St. Elizabeth School Scrip." Online orders ship to the school once a month. **All orders that are placed by the 1st Friday of the month will be delivered the following Thursday in your "Brown Envelope" with the youngest child.**
