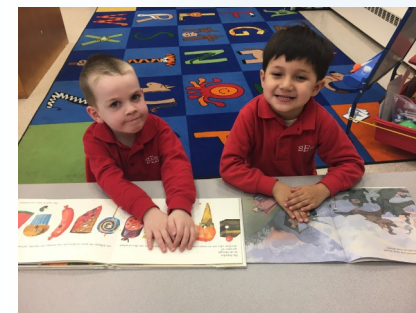

## Math

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Through daily math lessons and activities, children become familiar with math concepts that ensure full preparedness for kindergarten.

Children will study:

- ◆ Number Recognition and Counting
- ◆ Sorting Objects by Different Attributes
- ◆ Data Collection and Graphing
- ◆ Patterns
- ◆ Using Words to Describe Time

Number formation is also practiced and reinforced through our handwriting program.

## Language and Literacy

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Language and literacy are developed through pre-reading skills, such as letter recognition, letter sound recognition, and phonological awareness.

In depth work on story comprehension and concepts about print act as stepping stones to building confidence in reading.

Children will work on the following topics:

- ◆ Letter and Letter Sound Recognition
- ◆ Writing
- ◆ Oral Language
- ◆ Comprehension
- ◆ Phonological Awareness

## Science

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Children participate in hands-on activities that promote critical and scientific thinking.

Students will study the following topics:

- ◆ Life Cycles
- ◆ Seasons and Weather
- ◆ Healthy Habits
- ◆ The Five Senses
- ◆ Animals and Their Habitats

They will also become familiar with scientific terms, such as “predictions”, “experiment”, etc.

## Social Skills

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The development of social skills is fundamental to creating well-rounded students.

Children will:

- ◆ Demonstrate independence
- ◆ Independently solve conflicts with peers
- ◆ Display self-control
- ◆ Demonstrate manners and respect
- ◆ Interact well with peers
