ADMISSION POLICY

Student's Age

Pre-K3

Students must be 3 years old by October 1st of the calendar year and able to meet his/her own needs.

Pre-K4

Students must be 4 years old by October 1st of the calendar year and able to meet his/her own needs.

Kindergarten

Students must be 5 years old by October 1st of the calendar year.

Final admittance decisions for all grades are at the discretion of the administration.

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IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

The following are the immunization requirements for school entry in the state of New Jersey:

For entry into Pre-School

1. Polio – minimum of three doses
2. DPT – minimum of four doses
3. MMR – one given after 1st birthday
4. Hib – minimum of one dose given on or after 1st birthday
5. Varicella (chickenpox) – one given after the 1st birthday or documented proof of having had disease
6. Pneumococcal – one dose needed after 1st birthday
7. Influenza – ages 6-59 months and attending a Pre-K, one dose annually between September 1st and December 31st

For entry into Kindergarten

1. Polio – minimum of three doses (one dose must be given after the 4th birthday)
2. DPT – minimum of four doses (one dose must be given after the 4th birthday)
3. Measles – two doses given after the 1st birthday
4. Mumps – one dose given after the 1st birthday
5. Rubella – one dose given after the 1st birthday
6. Hepatitis B – three doses
7. Varicella (chickenpox) – one given after the 1st birthday or documented proof of having had disease

For entry into Grade 6

1. Meningococcal Conjugate Vaccine – one dose for ages 11 and older
2. TDAP – one dose upon entering Grade 6

Students entering grade 1 or grade 6 are now required to have three doses of Hepatitis B vaccine.

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SCHOOL POLICIES

Saint Elizabeth School is a Catholic Community of Faith where each person is accorded dignity and respect because he/she is made in the image and likeness of God. The following policies have been developed and implemented, and they apply to all students.

Students' Bill of Rights

I have the right to be safe at school. This means that no one will hit me, kick me, threaten me, or hurt me intentionally.

I have the right to be treated fairly. This means that no one will treat me differently and that the school rules will be applied equally to all people.

I have the right to be treated with compassion. This means that no one will purposely hurt my feelings.

- † Listen to instructions the first time they are given.
- † Listen when others are speaking.
- † Behave as fine human beings, generating pride in themselves, their schoolmates, their teachers, their school, their families, and their community.
- † Take care of school property such as textbooks, and other school materials.
- † Respect the property of others.
- † Act with honesty and humility at all times.

EXCEL (Extended Care Enriching Learning)

A Before Care program is available to all students. Children may be dropped off any time after 7:20 A.M. Supervision is provided. Parents will be billed per day. Statements will be sent home monthly. Prompt payment is expected.

An After Care program is available to all students. Hours of operation are from 2:15 until 6:00 P.M. The program is directed by two teachers and consists of supervised play and a quiet homework room. Parents will be billed an hourly rate. Statements will be sent home at the beginning of each month with the previous month's balance. Prompt payment is expected.
