



Welcome to First Grade! I am very excited to begin our year in September! The following supply list is separate from the Art Class supply list. On the first day of school, please have the following items in a soft zippered pencil case (for their desk) labeled with your child's name on it:

- 2 large glue sticks
- 1 large eraser
- 1 pair of scissors
- 5 sharpened pencils
- 1 box of Crayola crayons
- 1 yellow highlighter

In a LARGE ziplock bag labeled with your child's name please bring in the following (back up supplies):

- 3 packs of #2 sharpened pencils (12-24 per pack)
- 1 large pink eraser
- 2 boxes of Crayola crayons
- 6-8 large glue sticks
- 1 pair of scissors
- 2 boxes of Crayola washable markers
- 1 yellow highlighter

For your child please purchase the following:

- 3 durable two-pocket folders for:
(Take home, Writing, Spanish)
- 3 Primary composition notebooks for:
(Spelling, Writing, Interactive Sight Words)

For our classroom the following items are needed:

- 3 boxes of tissues
- 1 big bottles of hand sanitizer
- 1 box of GALLON size ZIPLOCK bags
- 3 tubs of Clorox wipes
- 1 package of long multi-colored construction paper
