

Dear Outgoing Third Grade Students and Parents,

In order to prepare for next year, we are utilizing the IXL program for the math summer work. As you know, IXL provides instant feedback and aids students in math comprehension by offering explanations of incorrect answers.

Summer math work will count as homework grades in the first trimester of 4<sup>th</sup> grade. IXL assignments are due on the first day of the 2018-2019 school year.

Students must complete work within each category listed below. Under each category, choose a minimum of 2 skills. While mastery is preferred and will provide the maximum benefit for the student, achieving 100% is not necessary. To receive full credit, students must attain 80% in the skills chosen. Please note below the skills to choose from. Some skills may be repeats of work done during the year.

(A)Numbers and Comparing	All except A.3
(B)Place Value	All
(C)Addition	All except: C.1, C.2
(D) Subtraction	All except: D.1
(E)Multiplication	All except: E.1, E.2
(G)Division	G.1 - G.6
(I)Mixed Operations	I.1, I.2
(J)Properties	All
(R)Geometry	All, except: R.6, R.8, R.12 – R.16
(T)Decimals	All
