To receive full credit, students must attain at least 80% in the skills listed below. Some skills may be repeats of work done during the year.

(D) Multiplication	D.18, D.24
(E) Division	E.5, E.8, E.13, E.20
(F) Mixed Operations	F.6
(P) Fractions	P.5, P.7, P.13, P.23
(T) Decimals	T.2, T.4

Students are encouraged to exceed these minimum requirements. Try additional skills! Answer more questions! Master the skills! In order to benefit from this review work, take your time and have pencil and paper next to you.
